3d Arts recognises the role that everyone needs to play keeping our community CovidSafe. The below policy is formulated in line with Government requirements and recommendations from peak performing arts bodies.

1. Preventing Covid at 3d Arts

Face Masks

- Face masks are recommended for
 - Positive Covid cases
 - Close contacts of Covid
 - Anyone with Covid symptoms
 - Anyone particularly vulnerable to Covid

Hygiene and Handwashing

- Venues will be regularly cleaned and sanitised by venue owners
- Hand sanitiser and/or sanitising wipes will be available at each venue's Welcome Desk
- Staff and students are encouraged to wash their hands frequently and well

Improving Air Quality

- Wherever possible, doors and windows should be opened to allow fresh airflow
- Wherever possible, air conditioning systems should be employed to increase airflow
- Wherever possible, air purifying systems should be employed

2. Record Keeping

Check-in

Student attendance must be recorded on 3d Arts' attendance rolls

3. Responding to Positive Covid Cases

- All staff and students should to take a RAT or PCR test at the first sign of Covid symptoms
- Victorian Government health advice encourages people with Covid to stay home
- 3d Arts prefers that anyone who is unwell should stay home for the safety of our community
